

- Modern educational management embraces a holistic approach that merges administrative expertise with the visionary leadership of trans formational educators.



The state of the art of strategic leadership

Strategic leadership was introduced in an article on "strategic choice" by Child (1972), who suggested that powerful individuals make strategic decisions based on the strategic choices that are available to them at a particular point in time, and that such decisions can impact myriad aspects of the organization, such as its goals and structure.

Most top management leadership is headed by a principals, who is responsible for making strategic decisions and managing the overall operations and resources of the entire organization rather than a single unit in that organization.
